There are three options please read them all and decide which one fits the best for your situation. Also, understand that this is just a temporary solution because the Club has already accepted the 2022 dues structure. Next year may include different membership categories. The options are based on other clubs like ours, and thought to be the best temporary alternatives. Some people will be happy, some will be angry, and some won't care. Let's try this and see how it goes! The options are:

- 1. Increase the resident membership by \$500, if the Non- Resident member would like access to ALL tee times only (no voting rights etc.) If this option is something you'd like, please call Bill Perry so he can add the \$500 to your account.
- 2. Pay a guest fee of \$40 for Non- Resident members if they would like to play during restricted tee times. Keep in mind that guest rules apply.
- 3. Keep your membership the same (no extra fees) and continue to follow the same rules as prior years with restricted tee times and the 24 hour open tee time rule


